ANIMISTIC GROUND: THE VOLCAN PROJECT

In 2017 I was given a grant from the Volcan Mountain Foundation to photograph the Volcan mountain range. Rising 5,700 feet, the range is the dominant scenic feature for a significant portion of San Diego's backcountry and is visible from the Pacific coastline 60 miles away. It is the headwaters for four major watersheds, including the San Dieguito and San Diego watersheds flowing to the Pacific Ocean. I have found Volcan Mountain to hold a wonderful mystique and quietness within it wildlands. In this project I've explored this mystery and solitude by photographing its regions that are normally not open to the public. I work intuitively and in a contemplative manner, slowly creating an intimate relationship between photographer and landscape.
