Culp lives and has a studio in Anza, CA, home of some very fine and paintable rocks. Coming from the eastern part of the United States, she was moved to purchase land there, build a studio to work in and a straw bale cabin to live in. "The Anza land looked to me like a national park in its sheer beauty," she notes. Jane Culp is an officially designated Resident Artist of California's Yosemite and Joshua Tree National Parks. There is a chapter featuring her and her Yosemite work in the 2013 book *Art in the National Parks* (Fresco Fine Arts).
