Santa Ysabel, Ca. - "Exploring Vessels," an exhibit by
Bill Porter, master blacksmith and Helen Wilson, painter-poet,
opens at the Santa Ysabel Gallery, Saturday, October 29, with
a reception to meet the artists from 4 to 8 p.m.

Wilson uses the mediumn of oil to depict the body and soul as vessels, Porter stretches the concept of the containing vessel by manipulating iron.

A Ramona resident, Wilson, received her formal training at Grossmont College, U. S. International University in San Diego and England and studied at the Free Academny of Arts, DEn Hague, The Netherlands.

Wilson works in oil on panel, canvas and vinyl, most usually of single subject matter, in the flavor of Georgia O'Keefe, the French cave painters and with Oriental simplicity.

IN 1972 Porter joined James Hubbell as a master craftsman, beginning an association that continues today. He has been involved in welding, forming and pouring cement, carving wood and forging steel, copper and bronze as well as the construction of three major buildings at the Hubbell studio. Porter also designed and built a diesel car kiln and constructed a foundry for melting and coasting of bronze.

Porter graduated from Calwestern University and has a lifetime California teaching certificate, he continued his education at Palomar College studing welding, ceramcis and hand blown glass; additional ceramics studies with Rhoda Lopez, UCSD, and an intensive

three week workshop with internationally noted blacksmith, Frank Turley, Santa Fe, NM.
