wagon to the Indian Agency for supplies. Friends and relatives gathered
at the Agency for a week-end of socalizing, rodeos and camping along
the Missouri River. These experiences have a profound affect on his
paintings.

Freeman is also known for painting murals, as a writer and as an illustrator.

His paintings and sculptures have received numerious awards through out the United States and his work has appeared in International competition and exhibitions. His most recent exhibition was by invitation to exhibit at the Citizens Gallery in Yokohama, Japan, as part of the sisters cities art exchange between San Diego, Tujuana and Yokohama.
