Santa Ysabel, Ca. (May, 1996) - "Landscapes of the Heart," Sculpture, glass, watercolors, and drawings by James Hubbell will be exhibited at the Santa Ysabel Gallery, opening Saturday, May 18 with a reception to meet the artist from 5 to 8 p.m.

and Primary School in Tijuana; in collaboration with local artists, a fountain in Vladivostok, Russia; and seven buildings comprising the Hubbell home and studio, Santa Ysabel.

The Santa Ysabel Gallery has, since opening at this location four years ago, offered the largest collection of work by James Hubbell anywhere for viewing and purchase by the public. In addition to the featured show, Hubbell's work can always by seen in one beautiful room at the gallery devoted exclusively to his work in stained glass, stone and metal sculpture, and jewelry. Jewelry is also displayed throughout the gallery. The proximity of the gallery to Hubbell's studio allows visitors to see his work in a beautiful mountain valley similar to where it is conceived and created.

Previous shows at the gallery spotlighting Hubbell's work include last year's "Into the Baja Garden" with watercolors, sculpture, and glass inspired by the dazzling blues, greens, and earthtones of the Baja California ocean and coastal areas, which Hubbell visits regularly.

The Hubbell show opens concurrently with the two-day Fifth Annual juried Santa Ysabel Art and Music Festival, featuring 75 artists and craftsmen, with continuous music and dance performances. The Festival is held on the Gallery grounds.
